 - All activities from the WP3 level were used in further work. The knowledge and skills we have gained at the negotiation and advocacy workshop, but also the experience and information during the round tables and meetings, are especially important. An important aspect of the experience is also elements from the strategy of dual education development and action plan.

 - There were no problems during realization of activity.

 - The second workshop was organized in Cacak, as the local self-government, representatives of the textile industry and the secondary School of Mechanical and Traffic expressed a desire to connect and build a partnership in the field of dual education. Partnerships in some form already existed, but the introduction of the dual model of education became more serious.

The workshop covered topics such as:

- What obstacles to involving employers into the dual education system,
- The advantages of the same system and





- Recommendations for the quality establishment of cooperation between educational institutions and the economy
- Implementation of dual education in Serbia
- Introduction of dual education law
- What techniques and methods did you use?

The methodology of the workshop included interaction among participants, answers to questions of small and medium-sized enterprises owners, exchange of experiences and examples of good practice

In the territory of the Raska and Moravica Administrative District for the next school year, classes for students who decided to educate themselves in dual model of education, will be realized in Cacak, Kraljevo, Gornji Milanovac, Novi Pazar and Sjenica for fashion tailors, in Kraljevo for furniture operators and in Kraljevo and Cacak for traders by dual.

The workshops were attended by the representatives of the Chamber of Commerce of Serbia-Regional Chamber of Commerce Kraljevo, the Deputy Mayor of the city of Cacak, the representatives of the City Administration of the city of Cacak, as well as representatives of companies and secondary vocational schools from Cacak. The workshops were also attended by the owners of small and medium enterprises.

The second workshop was attended by representatives of companies that participated in the study visit to Munich, March 2018 and the representatives of the Ministry of Education and Technology Development - School Board of the city of Cacak.

 - All parts of capacity building activities, from a theoretical and practical aspect, have been provided as a basis and a good experience for further action towards the realization of the project.

The biggest problem and barrier we face in contact with the owners of small and medium enterprises is the insufficiently developed awareness of the long-term benefits, importance and importance of dual education.
